What is the Sabbatical Scheme?

Language courses for teachers, lecturers, instructors and classroom assistants who want to develop their Welsh skills and gain confidence in the use of the language. The course is available at three levels – Entry and Foundation (Learners) and Higher (Fluent learners and first language Welsh speakers).

All courses are free. The Welsh Government will pay for the training as well as school supply costs, travel expenses and accommodation.
